KHAN ACADEMY

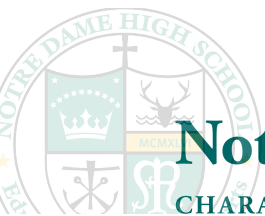
- COLLEGE BOARD has contracted with KHAN ACADEMY to develop an SAT PREP course

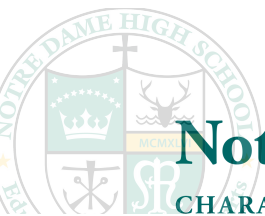
Application

- Personal Information - Data
- List of your activities
- Essay
 - Reflects something important about the student

Application Types

- **Early Decision**
 - Students who have a clear first choice
 - Binding Contract
 - Agree to withdraw all other applications if accepted
 - Can only apply early decision to ONE college
- **Early Action**
 - Apply earlier, but do not have a binding contract
 - May apply to multiple schools
- **Regular Decision**
- **Rolling Admissions**

Large City vs Small Town

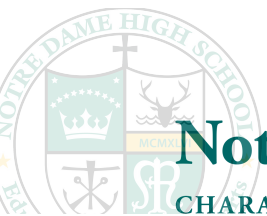
